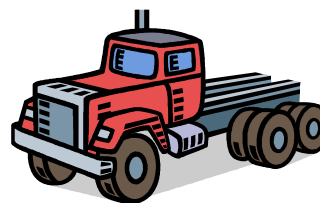
Open Class
