Cub Scout New Leaders

Designed for **ALL** volunteers and provides:

New Leader Essentials (NLE) 90 minutes

Need to attend only once.

Every adult (registered or not) working with the program is required to be YPT trained.

YPT 90 minutes

MUST be renewed every 3 years.

Required for **ALL** adult Cub Leaders.

Cub Leader Specific 3 hours

Required training each time position changes.

Anyone trained to this level is considered fully trained by the BSA.

BALOO 1 day
 (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)
 &
OWL
 (Outdoor Webelos Leader Training)

BALOO: For Cub leaders who go pack camping. This is required training for the Pack adult Leader planning and leading the overnighiter. Must register in advance.

OWL: Required for **ALL Webelos Leaders**. Emphasis is on camping, outdoor skills and outdoor Webelos pins. Must register in advance.

POW WOW 1 day
 Any Adult

For Cub leaders who go pack camping. This is required training for the Pack Adult Leader planning and leading the overnighiter. Must register in advance.

This is the 2nd largest training experience sponsored by the Sam Houston Area Council. It is a full day of fun and informative learning sessions led by experienced volunteers that will help you plan a quality program for your Den or Pack.
