• bucket for water to put out fire, fireplace tools, shovel for fire	• hiking boots/extra shoes (no sandals outside of camp)	• Cub Scout Handbook/pen/pencil	
	• socks (high tube is recommended, extra pairs or two)	• cord (nylon parachute cord is best - 50ft.)	
food/cooking	• underwear (for 2 extra days)	• trowel/shovel (one per den or pack)	
• stove/fuel (if desired and depends on Den eating arrangement)	• Shirts - t-shirts & long sleeve for bugs/sun/cold weather	• wood saw (one per den or pack)	
• cook pots (if desired and depends on Den eating arrangement)	• shorts	• camera/film/video	
• cups/plates/spoons/can opener (if desired and depends on Den eating arrangement)	• pants for bugs/sun/cold weather	• fishing gear	
• cooking utensils (if desired and depends on Den eating arrangement)	• sweater/fleece jacket/sweat shirt	• compass	
• matches in waterproof container	• rain pants		
• plastic bags for storage/trash/clothes	• rain jacket	mandatory
